You can find GSEF reception desk at the gate 19 at Incheon Airport. A staff will guide you how to take limousine bus at the airport to the hotel.

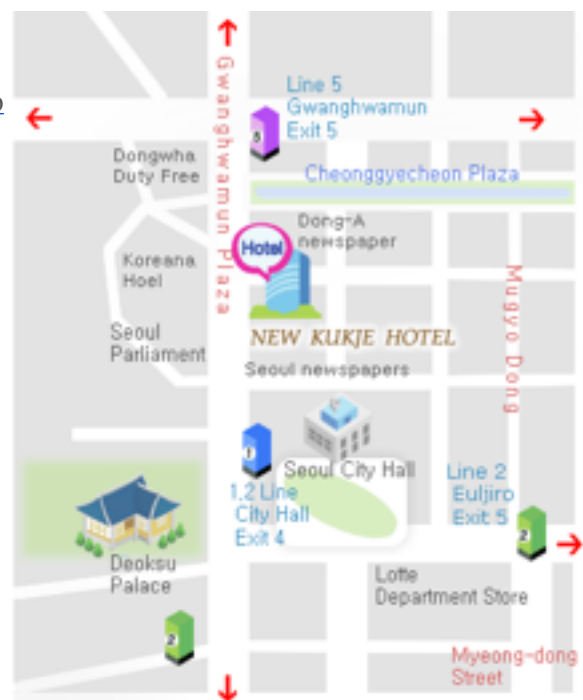

A. Transportation



T-money Cards are rechargeable transportation cards, which can be used on subways, buses and taxis. T-money Cards can be purchased for 2,500 won(about \$2.30) each using T-money Vending Devices (limited availability) or convenient store and recharged them using the Ticket Vending and Card Reload Devices located inside subway stations. Information desk in subway station will give away maps but you can easily download the app “Subway Korea”(Jihachul) for free to have more information. (On 4-5, coach will be provided.)
