With a size eight times larger than that of Taipei City, New Taipei City is highly urbanized and features countryside, diverse natural landscapes, and a diverse population and industry composition, attracting people from all over Taiwan to settle and work here.

The First City in Taiwan to Announce VLR

In 2018, New York became the first city in the world to announce VLR. In July 2019, New Taipei City, Oaxaca, and Buenos Aires followed suit and completed VLR. New Taipei City became the first city in Taiwan to announce VLR.

Industries

New Taipei City possesses diverse industries comprising companies of all sizes. Its major industries are computer peripherals, information technology, and biotechnology. It also boasts the world's top five manufacturers of wedding dresses, electronic surgical instruments, and LED bulbs. Its high-tech industry clusters make it a crucial member of the global market. Companies such as Amazon and Google have established innovation centers in T-Park, Alibaba is working with New Taipei City to build an international trading market, and Microsoft is collaborating with New Taipei City to promote industrial AI transformation platforms.
