

■ Brief Information on Gyeonggi Province and the Conference

Gyeonggi Province is located in the west-central region and surrounds Seoul, the capital of Korea. The area of Gyeonggi Province is 10,189 km², accounting for approximately 10.2% of the total land area of South Korea. Its population has reached about 12.9 million and it is steadily increasing. Gyeonggi Province is the most populous region and consists of 28 cities and 3 counties.

Gyeonggi Province legislated the Provincial by law on Fostering the Local Social Economy in 2015 to support social enterprises, cooperatives, community enterprises, self-sufficient enterprises and non-profit organizations. The province is home to some 2,200 social economy organizations, which together hire over 12,000 persons. The aggregate revenue of these organizations account for 0.078 percent of the gross regional domestic product of the province. Regarding these stats, it is still much smaller than traditional economy in the scale that social economy in Gyeonggi province. Though its short history, the social economy is rapidly growing in Gyeonggi and other regions in South Korea.







A multitude of social economy initiatives are seeking to bring social change in a better way to communities around Gyeonggi Province. However, they face the challenges of ensuring sustainability in maintaining and developing their activities as well as supporting their businesses.

Noting Gyeonggi Province's effort to foster the local social economy by introducing social finance, and observing the growing need for developing the related policies, laws, and institutions, we came to organize this international conference exclusively dedicated to social finance and related topics.

Thus, we would like to introduce the very first international conference under the theme of 'Social Finance' from the 25th to the 27th of October. The Governor of Gyeonggi Province as well as representatives from local governments and social economy enterprises and networks are expected to attend.
