Examples of training and capacity-building programs conducted by the GSEF *(in person or online)*

Dakar, Senegal • Training with the Platform of Non-State Actors of Senegal and the International Organization of Francophonie, leading to the creation of the RACTES hybrid network bringing together local governments and actors involved in the SSE.

Mexico • National workshop with Mexico's National Institute of the Social Economy, bringing together 111 local, regional and federal government representatives.

Kampala, Uganda • Training session for over 60 SSE leaders and practitioners in Uganda and East Africa.

GSEF-CGLUA-ALGA program • Online training on inspiring SSE policies and practices, in collaboration with UCLG Africa and the African Academy of Local Government, bringing together 35 participants from 15 countries and 3 continents.
